494th National Adventure Programme at Pachmarhi, Madhya Pradesh

A group of 17 students from the Department of Physical Education, accompanied by two faculty members, i.e., Mr. Madan Mohan Yadav and Ms. Kirti Malik, attended the 494th National Adventure Programme organized by The Bharat Scouts and Guides National Adventure Institute at Pachmarhi, Madhya Pradesh from 04.04.2024 to 10.04.2024. Geographic Excursion to Udaipur and Chittorgarh

A four-days Geographic Excursion to Udaipur and Chittorgarh was organized by the Geography Department from 11.04.2024 to 15.04.2024. A group of students from the department accompanied by three faculty members, i.e., Mr. Himanshu Grover, Mr. Sachin, and Dr. Anita, participated in the expedition. The education trip included interactive sessions over the geographical principles of hydrological processes and ecosystem dynamics at the Fateh Sagar Lake, the impact of human intervention over the physical landscape at the historic garden of Saheliyon ki Bari with Mughal-era architecture, geological surveys at the rugged terrain of the Aravali Ranges, discussions over the complexities of urban geography at Moti Magri and City palace, and socio-economic and physical landscape surveys at the hinterlands near Chittorgarh. The analyses of the surveys was done through geographic methodologies like mapping exercises and spatial analysis, which helped the students assess the village's environmental sustainability and identify areas for intervention to address the socio-environmental issues. The expedition helped the students learn the real-world applications of their theoretical knowledge.
